Please assist your child in recording chapter books her or she reads from January 23 – March 6 on a Read-a-thon book form. **YOU MAY ALSO RECORD ANY BOOKS THAT YOU READ TO YOUR CHILD.** Your signature on the report form indicates that the book has been read, and that the book was read between the dates of January 23 – March 6. However, we ask that students wait until an entire book has been completed before reporting any pages for that title.

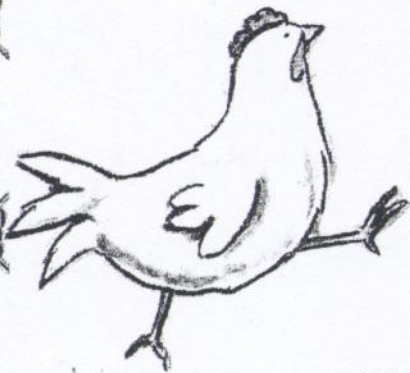
