It is time to begin the FRA Read-a-thon, intended to encourage reading at all ages by rewarding students for reaching individual goals.

Please record on a Read-a-thon book form any **Excellent** book (picture book) or **Chapter** book your child reads from January 29 through March 8. **You may also record any books that you read to your child.** Send the form back to your child's classroom teacher. Additional forms are available in the classroom or in the library.

A star chart is kept for each student in each class. Students will receive one star for every 5 **Excellent** books read. (An **Excellent** book is a heavily-illustrated book, usually with no more than 60 pages.) Students will also receive a star for every 50 pages read from a **Chapter** book. (A **Chapter** book has few illustrations and is usually more than 60 pages in length.) We ask that for chapter books, students wait until the entire book has been completed before reporting any pages for that title.

Additional copies of the reporting form are available from the Read-a-thon link of the Library website. To access our site, choose either the "Parents" or "Students" link on the FRA Home Page, then select "Library LS" from the Quick Links list in the portal. On the Library main page, click the Read-a-thon button to link to copies of the reporting form and information letter.

First graders may also read nonfiction books on their reading level, if these are read cover-to-cover. These books are entered on the E-book portion of the reporting form.
