## KINDERGARTEN

It is time to begin the FRA Read-a-thon, intended to encourage reading at all ages.

At the kindergarten level participants reach whole-class goals, rather than individual goals. **Please record any book that you or other friends or relatives read to your kindergartner during the Read-a-thon, January 29-March 8. Also record any books your kindergartner reads to you.** Remember, each book can be read and recorded only one time.

Just write the title of the book read, sign your name, and send it in with your child daily or weekly. Additional copies of the reporting form are available from the Read-a-thon link on the Library website. To access our site, choose either the "Parents" or "Students" link on the FRA Home Page, then select "Library LS" from the Quick Links list in the portal. On the Library main page, click the Read-a-thon button to link to copies of the reporting forms and this information letter.

Great references for picture books are also available on our website. Select "Reading Suggestions" for lists of students and faculty favorite books, and a "Links to Great Reading" choice which provides access to lists of great literature including Caldecott books and 100 Picture Books Everyone Should Know.

A sticker will be put on the class chart for each book read. As the stickers add up and the class reaches each new incentive level, the appropriate award will be given to all members of the class.
