

Dear Prospective FRA Family,

Franklin Road Academy is thrilled about your interest in our school and our financial aid program; therefore, this letter was created to ensure that you are informed about the financial aid application process for the upcoming school year. We recognize that an FRA education is a long-term investment in your child's future. FRA provides an outstanding education and opportunities in athletics, arts, and philanthropy; thus, need-based financial aid is available for families who need assistance in meeting the costs of an independent school education.

The Franklin Road Academy Financial Aid program strives to serve as many qualified families as possible. The amount of aid awarded to each family is subject to the amount of aid available and number of applications. New student aid awards are given on a first-come, first-serve basis. All financial aid decisions are made without regard to race, religion, or national origin and are handled separately from the admission process.

It is the policy of FRA to award aid based on the evaluations made by FACTS Aid Assessment of Lincoln, Nebraska. FACTS provides need-based financial aid analysis for schools across the country and operates in accordance with FRA requirements. Financial aid awards will be considered as soon as possible once a completed analysis has been received from FACTS. Please note that there is a designated amount of funds available each school year; therefore, applicants are encouraged to apply as soon as possible. The Financial Aid Committee will begin evaluating financial aid applications in February and will contact the parent /guardian once a decision has been made.

Prospective FRA families should submit completed financial aid applications no later than April 30, 2012. Visit http://www.franklinroadacademy.com/admission/tuition_financial_aid.cfm to find all required forms. **Financial aid applications and verification must be completed by April 30, 2012.** When completing your application, please be very thorough. All fields on the application should be completely filled to the best of your knowledge.

Financial aid is granted on a yearly basis and is not assured from one year to the next unless specifically stated through the administration of a scholarship endowment or other such program. Financial aid information is strictly confidential.
