



FRA Privacy Statement

Creating an Online User Account

When you enroll your child at FRA, you provide detailed information on the Student Identification Form, on your contract, as well as on other forms you may later submit to the school. This information is used to create user accounts for you and your student(s) which enable you to use the online resources available. Changes in this personal information, especially the Student Information Form, should be updated online, at least once each year. FRA is the sole owner of the information collected on this website.

Gifts

Personally identifiable information is submitted to FRA on donation forms. This includes information such as name, email, mailing address, and financial information such as credit card number and expiration date. This information is used for billing purposes only. It will be used to contact you if a problem is encountered in the donation process.

Social Security Numbers

Social security numbers are collected when Upper School students complete college applications. Information submitted to FRA online is encrypted by secure socket layer technology (SSL).

Uses of Information

FRA uses personal information to contact you (or other appropriate individuals that you specify) in the event of an emergency involving your child. This information is also used for accounting and communication purposes.

Aggregate information (such as the number of students enrolled) is shared with organizations that accredit FRA. Shared information does not identify individuals. Personally identifying information (such as transcripts) to third parties (such as colleges) is provided at your request only. This information is not released to third parties without your express permission.

Communications

FRA newsletters are available on the FRA Website. You may request email notification of weekly newsletters and other announcements. Please provide us with an email address if you would like to receive these notices. Call or write the FRA Data Coordinator to indicate that you do not wish to receive email communications. FRA does not share email addresses with third parties.

Legal Disclaimer

FRA reserves the right to disclose your personally identifiable information as required by law and when it is necessary to protect our rights and/or to comply with a judicial proceeding, court order, or legal process served on the FRA Website.

Log Files

Most websites gather certain information automatically and store it in log files. This information includes internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser types, referring/exit pages, operating systems, and date/time stamps. This information, which does not identify individual users, is used to analyze trends, to administer the site, to track users' movements around the site, and to gather demographic information about the user base as a whole. Automatically-collected data is not linked to personally identifiable information.

Cookies

A cookie is a small text file that is stored on a user's computer for record-keeping purposes. Cookies are used on the FRA Website, but they are not required. Information stored in cookies is not linked to personally identifiable information. Session ID cookies make it easier for you to navigate the FRA Website. A session ID cookie expires when a browser is closed.

Links to Other Sites

The FRA Website contains links to other sites that are neither owned nor controlled by FRA. Please be aware that FRA is not responsible for the privacy practices of such other sites. Web users are encouraged to read the privacy statements of each and every website that collects personally identifiable information. This privacy statement applies only to information collected by this website.

Bulletin Boards

Any personally identifiable information submitted to bulletin boards on the FRA Website can be read, collected, or used by other users of these forums, and could be used for the purposes of sending unsolicited mail. FRA is not responsible for the personally identifiable information which users submit in these forums.

Security

FRA respects the security of your personal information. When sensitive information (such as credit card number and/or social security number) is entered on forms submitted to FRA, it is encrypted using secure socket layer technology (SSL). Additional information about SSL is available at:
