Registration and Dance Tuition Cost:

Registration into a dance class will be for the school calendar year. Dance tuition will be billed for the year and can be paid either in full at registration, or you may choose to pay each semester with first payment due at registration and second payment due January 5. Tuition does not include any dancewear needed for class or costumes for performances.

45-minute class	\$700 per year/ \$350 per semester
1-hour class	\$750 per year/ \$375 per semester
1 ¼ hour class	\$800 per year/ \$400 per semester
1 ¾ hours of class	\$900 per year/ \$450 per semester
2 hours	\$950 per year/ \$475 per semester

- All classes will be taught by certified professional teachers, and classes will be held in the FRA Dance Studio.
